

### Visiting tips:

- Register for a VPASS to expedite your visitation process.
- Once you arrive in McFarland, use the street address, not your GPS, to find your way to the Golden State Modified Community Correctional Facility, since your GPS will not take you there directly. (Golden State MCCF/SNY, 611 Frontage Road, McFarland, CA 93250)
- For safety and security reasons, make sure your phone is turned off and your valuables are hidden well before leaving your car (the trunk is a good place).
- Not all institutions adhere to the same rules regarding what to wear/not to wear, but here are a few general rules to follow:
  - No hoodies, scarves, sunglasses (unless prescription), flip-flops, backless shoes, see-through clothes, or sleeveless shirts are allowed.
  - No pants that look like leggings.
  - You cannot wear any shades of beige, blue, brown, or green clothes as they conflict with the officers' and staffs' clothing
- Be sure to bring an extra set of clothes (FULL set—shoes, shirt, pants/skirt, and even underclothes) in your car in case you wore something that you're not allowed. Do not wear an underwire bra.
- To be safe, ask if what you are wearing is appropriate when you arrive.
- Wearing jewelry *is* allowed, except for watches.
- You can only come in with 10 pictures to show to the prisoner you are visiting, money in a plastic bag, your driver's license, and a car key
- You are not allowed to take food and drinks in the prison with you, but they can be purchased from machines in the visiting room during a visit. You are allowed to take money in with you (only quarters or dollars) for that purpose. It must be carried in a see-through bag.
- There is a place at the prison where you can exchange \$20 bills for dollars and quarters.
- It's a big treat for a prisoner to have a visitor and it's a big treat for them to have a drink and something to eat, so keep that in mind when you bring change for food.
- You are not allowed take out any food or drinks you purchase while there, but must consume it all during the visit or throw it away before leaving.
